Meijer Members at Top Rate to Receive Wage Increase

When the Meijer 2015 wage schedule becomes effective on August 30, members who are at top rate will receive a wage increase. The contractually mandated wage increase should appear on members' September 3, 2015 paychecks.

"These wage increases are the result of contract negotiations between the union and Meijer," John Cakmakci, UFCW 951 president, said. "Mistakes do happen, so it's important for members at top rate to check their paychecks to make sure they are getting paid properly."

Meijer members who are not at top rate will remain at their current wage rate and not have their hours reset until they reach the next higher wage rate in their classification.
