## **Hillary Clinton**

- ✓ Stood with striking workers at Plum Island in their two year battle against a bad contractor. Together, they were successful in getting a new contractor and returning union members to work.
- ✓ Fought for legislation to extend workers' unemployment benefits during the 2008 economic crisis.
- ✓ Assisted union members in negotiating new contracts.
- ✓ Intervened with the Bush administration to protect the jobs of U.S. workers threatened by Chinese trade barriers.

## **Donald Trump**

- ✗ Thinks workers wages are too high, and corporations should threaten to move production to force wages down.
- ✗ Refuses to recognize a union election at his hotel.
- ✗ Crossed a picket line established by the crew of "The Apprentice."
- ✗ Makes huge profits by outsourcing his apparel lines, home furnishings and hotel amenities to at least 12 low-wage countries including China, South Korea and Mexico.
- ✗ Has been sued by hundreds of workers to get paid for completed jobs, overtime and minimum wage.
