## SETTING THE RECORD STRAIGHT ON mPERFORMANCE

Meijer has implemented a new discipline system, and there are a few facts members at Meijer need to know about it.



1. UFCW 951 DID **NOT** agree to the new system.
2. The discipline system is not part of the union contract.
3. UFCW 951 and its members have the right to file grievances contesting any unjust discipline.

To ensure that the new discipline system is fair members are encouraged to follow these tips.

1. If you have any questions about mPerformance, ask your manager/supervisor.
2. Check your discipline/attendance record daily. Management can help you access Workday while you are punched in.
3. If your record doesn't seem correct, talk to your Union Steward or Representative.
