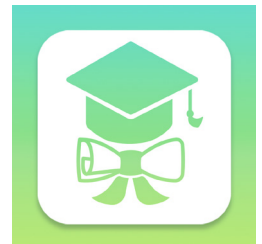

# REDUCED COST BACHELOR'S DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAM AVAILABLE TO MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES

Through this online bachelor completion program, eligible students who have an associate degree or have earned 60 or more credits in their chosen field of study, can apply to attend Central State University (CSU) online at a highly discounted cost.



CSU is a respected, regionally-accredited university governed by the Ohio Department of Higher Education and is part of the University System of Ohio.

Eligible students will receive a Student Success Grant that will reduce their out-of-pocket cost to no more than \$4,500 per year, for full-time students. Depending on federal or employer grants available, many students may pay much less, or even zero out-of-pocket.
